

2019 ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING

The Annual Meeting of the membership for electing five member Board of Managers and approval of the 2019 Annual Budget held on SATURDAY. JANUARY 26, 2019 at 12:00 NOON. The meeting location will be at the Bush Fire Station on Hwy. 21.

The voting will be in writing by those members authorized to cast votes. To assist you, ballots are enclosed with this Newsletter that are personalized with your name(s), the lot(s) you own and your total voting acres.

According to the By-Laws, Article II, 5, before any meeting can be held a quorum of 40% of the voting rights present or represented by a notarized proxy must be present. Association has had in place for years a method of determining a quorum beforehand in order for the annual meeting to commence promptly at 12:00 noon. Enclosed with your ballot is a numbered envelope which when used in mailing your ballot will help determine the acreage votes submitted to reach a quorum of 502.04 This will also alert the Association that it is a ballot to be submitted to the Election Committee. **ENVELOPE RECEIVED** WITHOUT A NUMBER WILL BE ASSUMED TO BE SOMETHING

OTHER THAN A BALLOT AND WILL BE OPENED.

Ballots will be considered by the Election Committee as invalid if:

- ** The ballot is not signed.
- ** The ballot has more than 5 candidates selected. You must vote for up to 5 candidates.

In voting for the annual budget, another copy is enclosed.

In accordance with the By-Laws, Article V, 6, enclosed is a copy of the 2018 yearly itemization of expenses and amounts received.
